

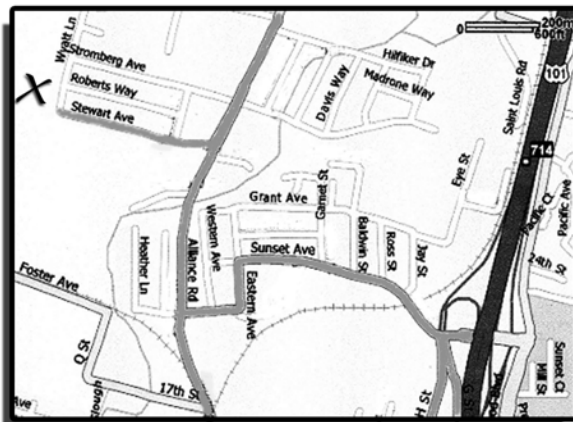
Get the Knowledge & Experience to Garden with Confidence!

The Gardener Training Program is a fifteen-week program offering 1 hour of lecture / discussion and 7 hours of in-field training each week. You lend your hands to keep our farm going and we take time to pass on our knowledge and experience. As a bonus, you'll receive ample veggies, and a copy of Eddie's book, "The Humboldt Kitchen Gardener." No experience necessary; expect to get dirty!

We are offering two sessions in 2010; one from April 5th to July 15th and one from July 19th to October 28th.

Where It's At

Deepseeded Community Farm is an 9-acre CSA vegetable farm providing weekly baskets of seasonal produce to farm members. We are located at the west end of Stewart Avenue in Arcata, which is off of Alliance Road near the Westwood Shopping Center.
